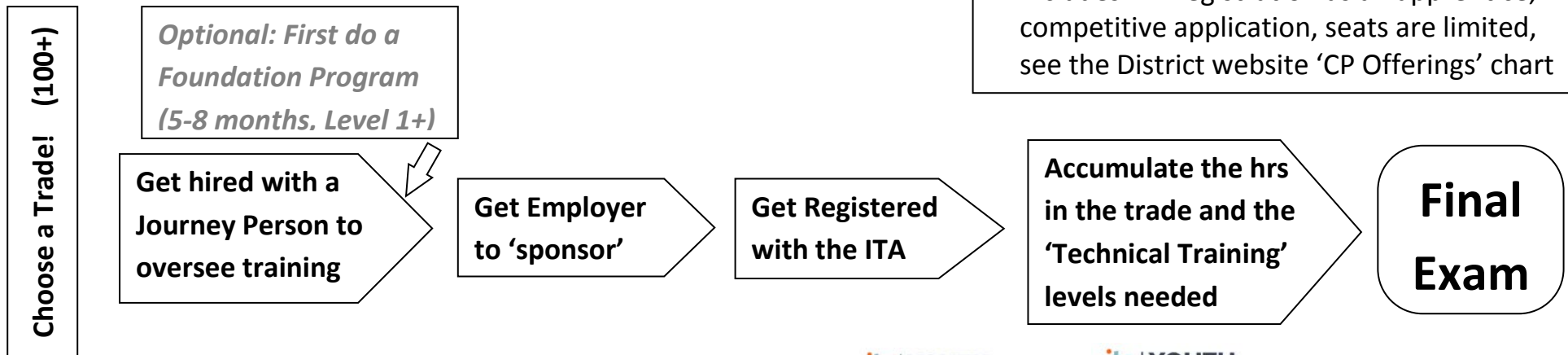


Start your pathway early! Grade 10/11/12

- **WBT** (Work Based Training) = learning takes place by working with a Journeyperson
 - **Technical Training** = classroom theory (may include a limited practical component)
 - **Foundation Program** (aka Pre-App, ELTT) = 'Technical Training' PLUS a practical component
 - **Train in Trades** = Taking a 'Technical Training' or 'Foundation' program in Secondary School

DUAL Train & Work? = yes you can! It's the recommended path for successful continuation

- ✓ **'Youth Work in Trades' (WBT)**
 - Age 15 or older, you need to get hired with a Journeyperson, & sponsored, & registered with the ITA, earn up to 16 credits, \$1000 possible scholarship too.
- ✓ **'Youth Train in Trades': (Technical Training)**
 - Can be Level 1 or a Foundation, Gr11 or 12, includes ITA registration as an apprentice, competitive application, seats are limited, see the District website 'CP Offerings' chart
