Dear Parents/Guardians,

B.C. youth aged 12+ can now register to get vaccinated against COVID-19.

How to register

- If you were born in 2009 or earlier (12+), please visit <https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/covid-19/vaccine/register> to register with the Get Vaccinated provincial registration system.
- If you don't have a Personal Health Number, you will need to register by phone. Please call: 1-833-838-2323. Translators are available.
- When you register, you will get a confirmation number. Please keep it somewhere safe as you will need it to book your vaccination appointment.
- When it's your turn to book a vaccine appointment, you will be contacted either online or by phone.

If a parent/guardian has a vaccine appointment booked for themselves already, they can take their child(ren) with them to get vaccinated at the same time. When you arrive at the vaccination clinic, please let staff know that your children require the vaccination too. Please ensure all family members bring identification and ideally their personal health card if they have one. Please also register your child on the Get Vaccinated provincial registration system. This will ensure they receive notification to book their second dose in a timely manner.

Where to get vaccinated

In Delta, vaccination clinics are located at:

- Delta COVID-19 Testing and Immunization Centre, 4470 Clarence Taylor Crescent
