LANGUAGE INSTRUCTION FOR NEWCOMERS TO CANADA (LINC)

Free basic English language courses are available for adult newcomers to Canada funded by the Government of Canada, through Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC)

- Open to Permanent Residents and Convention Refugees over the age of 17
- Canadian citizens or refugee claimants are not eligible for LINC
- Immigrants who wish to study in the LINC Program must first be tested at the Surrey Language Assessment Centre. Please phone 604-507-4150 to book a test

English Foundations

- English Foundations level 1 through level 7
- These classes build on each other with level 7 preparing students for English 11 and up

Math Foundations

- Math Foundations level 4 through level 7
- These classes build on each other with Level 7 preparing students for Math 11

Info Tech Foundations

- Computer skills, keyboarding, MS Word, Excel and PowerPoint, internet search skills, email basics, attachments, photos and the use of smartphones and apps

Support Courses

- Companion speaking, reading, listening and writing courses help students as they progress through the different Adult English Foundations levels



HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION

Delta Community College offers several tuition-free ways for you to successfully complete or upgrade your high school graduation courses:

Adult Graduation Diploma

- The program consists of 20 credits or 5 courses
- Students must be 18 years old or older and not enrolled in a high school as of September 30

2018 Graduation Program

- The program consists of 80 credits for students entering grade 10 after July 1, 2018

Classroom learning

- Structured in-class instruction offers the support of an instructor to help you reach your goals

- Proof of Canadian Status (i.e., Canadian Birth Certificate, Canadian Citizenship Card, Certificate of Indian Status, Permanent Resident Card, Refugee status document or one-year Work Permit)
- Proof of Residency in BC (i.e., BC Driver's License, BC ID or BC Care Card)
- Picture ID

There is a charge for assessments. We accept cash, Visa, MasterCard, American Express and cheques. We do not accept debit cards.
